Abstract Submission

ABSTRACTS DUE ON OR BEFORE MARCH 1

All abstracts must be submitted in PDF format and presented in clear English with accurate grammar and spelling of a quality suitable for publication. The author is expected to attend the meeting and present the abstract as a **4x6 landscape color poster** as part of the Friday March 31st oral poster competition. If an abstract was previously submitted to a different meeting it may still be submitted to the New York State Pain Society Annual Meeting and Scientific Sessions. The presenting author must be a Medical Student, Resident or Fellow and is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission to the Society. Co-authors need not be Residents or Fellows.

Guidelines for Submission

Your Abstract must include:

- Presenting Author's Contact Details
- Full first and family name(s) (as you wish for these to be published on the Program USB and Final Program)
- Full postal address
- Email address (required as all communications will be by electronic mail)
- Daytime and evening phone numbers
- Author and Co-Authors' Details
- Affiliation details: department, institution / hospital, city, state (if relevant), country
- Abstract Title (Limited to 25 words)
- Abstract Text Limited to 500 words (Please Note: word count is affected when graphs/tables/images are added)

<u>Abstract topic:</u> Abstracts must be allocated to a specific topic for the scientific program. Please choose from the following topics:

- Basic Science
- Clinical Application
- Medically Challenging Case

Prize Packages for Trainees in Poster Competition

The Society will award travel prizes of \$500 each — for best clinical abstract, best basic research abstract, and best medically challenging case. On Friday, April 1, posters are to be displayed by noon. At 6:00 p.m., an oral poster competition is scheduled at which each Trainee Scholar presenter will give a 3 minute oral presentation on his / her poster. All Trainee Scholar oral presenters are eligible to win \$750 for best oral poster presentation.
